Peanut Butter Recall

Scottsdale, Ariz. – (Jan. 19, 2009) – On Jan. 10, we were notified that King Nut, an independent supplier of peanut butter to certain distributors that provide peanut butter to a limited number of Cold Stone franchisees in Arizona, Idaho and North Dakota, was the focus of an investigation by the FDA and other regulatory agencies concerning a recent Salmonella outbreak. Because the safety and welfare of our customers is Cold Stone Creamery's top concern, we responded immediately by removing all King Nut peanut butter from our stores and replacing it with any other commercial or grocery store brand peanut butter. To date, there have been no Salmonella cases directly linked to Cold Stone Creamery. We will continue to proactively work with appropriate public health agencies, taking every measure possible to ensure our customers' well being.
