**Peanut Butter Recall Isolated to Arizona, Idaho and North Dakota**

**Scottsdale, Ariz. – (Jan. 20, 2009)** – A limited number of Cold Stone Creamery stores in Arizona, Idaho and North Dakota had received peanut butter from the Peanut Corporation of America, under the private King Nut label. The manufacturer of this product is the focus of an investigation by the FDA concerning a recent Salmonella outbreak.

Upon learning of the investigation on Jan. 10, Cold Stone Creamery responded immediately by removing all King Nut peanut butter from stores in those three states and replacing it with other commercial or grocery store brand peanut butter. To date, no confirmed cases have been linked to Cold Stone Creamery.

“The safety and welfare of our customers is our top concern. We will continue to proactively work with appropriate public health agencies, taking every measure possible to ensure our customers’ well being,” stated a Company spokesperson.
